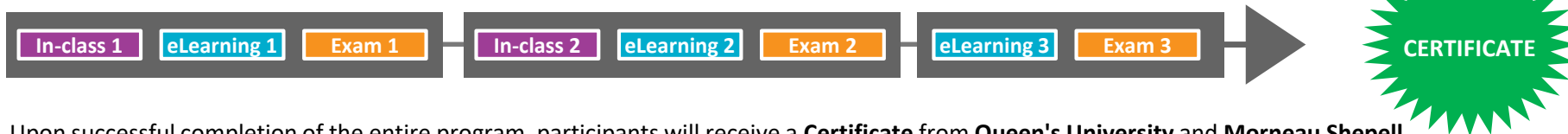


# Workplace Mental Health Leadership™ Certificate Program

<b>Introduction to a Mentally Healthy Workplace</b> High-level introduction to the topic of mental health in the workplace. Designed to create awareness of the impact of mental health issues and serves as the foundation for building knowledge and practical skills throughout the program.			<b>The Leader's Role in Managing a Mentally Healthy Workplace</b> In-depth development of leader skills by using the Mental Health Framework to look at managing prevention, early performance coaching, recovery, absence and return to work.			<b>Promoting a Mentally Healthy Workplace</b> Based on the National Standard for Psychological Health and Safety in the Workplace, explores foundational leadership practices and factors that promote mental health at work.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>In-class 1 and 2 are 3.5 hour instructor-led classroom sessions. Module 3 has no in-class session.</b></li> <li>• <b>eLearning 1, 2 and 3 are one-hour online sessions.</b></li> <li>• <b>Online exams 1, 2 and 3 have 10 multiple choice questions. Participants are given three attempts to achieve a passing score of 70% in each exam.</b></li> </ul>							

- The program must be completed sequentially, as indicated in this learning path, i.e., complete **In-class 1 and 2** on separate days, followed by the **eLearning** and **Online exams** at your own pace:



- Upon successful completion of the entire program, participants will receive a **Certificate** from **Queen's University** and **Morneau Shepell**.
- Completion of each module will be tracked in Morneau Shepell's Learning Management System.
- For Modules 1 and 2, access to the **eLearning** will be granted once attendance at the **In-class** session has been verified by Morneau Shepell (which can take up to 2 days).
- After completing each **In-class** session, participants should plan to complete the corresponding **eLearning** and **Exam** within 30 – 60 days.
- Recommended completion of the entire program is 4-6 months. However, this timeline may vary based on the agreement between your organization and Morneau Shepell at the time the program is booked.
